The Tradition of the Rider Rock

The Rider Rock was initiated by students in 2006 to honor generations of Rider students, past, present and future and to connect them to the symbolic Rider Elm, the emblem of learning and the cycles of life.

Incoming Rider students touch the Rider Rock following New Student Convocation, and graduating seniors complete the cycle on Commencement Day. At the end of their Commencement ceremony on the Campus Green, graduates have an opportunity to walk by and touch the Rider Rock, which is located adjacent to the Bart Luedeke Center Patio.

The five-foot-high granite rock is inscribed with Rider's motto, the Latin words "In Omnia Paratus," which translates to "in all things prepared," along with the insignia of the tree of knowledge and 1865, the year Rider was founded. The inscription continues, "By touching the Rider Rock, we affirm our commitment to the pursuit of knowledge and the betterment of our world. Through the time we spent here, we are forever joined to the past and future generations of students and to Rider University."

Academic Heraldry

The wearing of caps, gowns, and hoods at college and university functions dates back to the Middle Ages when they were first worn by monks and students in order to keep warm in the damp and drafty 12th-century castles and halls of learning. Through the years, their style and color have come to represent certain exact meanings.

- Gowns for the associate's and bachelor's degrees, worn through undergraduate study, have a semi-stiff yoke, long pleated front and intricate shirring across the shoulders and back. The gown is worn closed and is primarily distinguished by its long, pointed sleeves.
- The gown for the master's degree has the same yoke effect as that of the bachelor's, but is so designed that it may be worn open or closed. The back of the sleeve is oblong and square cut.
- Gowns for the doctoral degree are also worn open or closed. They have long velvet panels down the front and three velvet bars on the bell-shaped sleeves. This velvet trimming may be either black or the color distinctive of the field of learning to which the degree pertains.
- Certain changes were made in 1960, and some colleges and universities have departed from the traditional black and adopted gowns in the official colors of the institution.
- Caps may be of serge, broadcloth, cotton, rayon, or silk, or, for the doctor's outfit only, velvet. Caps may be mortarboards or soft, square-topped caps. The tassel of the associate's and bachelor's caps may be black thread; the tassel for the master's cap, silver thread; and the tassel of the doctor's cap, gold thread.
- At Rider University, the tassel color indicates graduation with honors: undergraduate degree candidates receiving their degree with honors, cum laude, magna cum laude, or summa cum laude, wear white tassels. Master's degree candidates receiving their degree with distinction wear tassels of cranberry.
- The hood gives further color and meaning to the academic costume. The hood is a shell of varying sizes for the baccalaureate and graduate degrees and of material to match the gown. It is lined with the color or colors of the institution conferring the degree and is bordered with velvet of the proper width and color to indicate the field of learning:

Accountancy, Business, Commerce	Drab
Education	Light Blue
Liberal Arts and Sciences	White
Music	Pink
Nursing	Apricot

- The robe worn by the president of Rider University was presented by the Rider University Chapter of the American Association of University Professors to Dr. Rozanski on the occasion of his inauguration as the sixth president of Rider. The robe is cranberry and white, the University's official colors. It is worn by the president at formal academic occasions at the University.
- The mace, carried at the head of the procession, is a traditional symbol of authority at governmental, ecclesiastical and scholarly occasions. Originally a warlike implement, it has evolved in form and fabric to fit its present ceremonial purpose. Of silver and ebony, the mace of Rider University is a memorial to Roland T. Henderson, Class of 1949, and was presented in 1975 by his widow, Elizabeth. The names of the six Rider presidents are engraved on the mace.

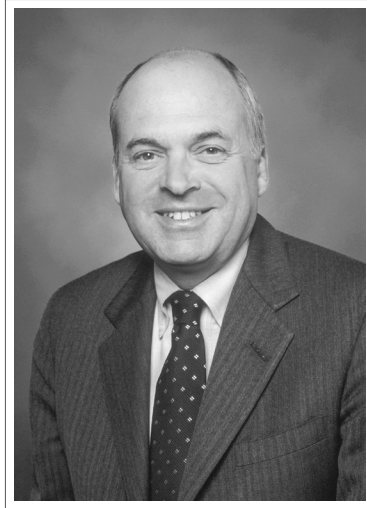

Honorary Doctor of Laws



DR. J. BARTON LUEDEKE

Rider University is proud to award the Honorary Doctor of Laws to Rider University President Emeritus, Dr. J. Barton Luedeke at its 150th Commencement ceremony.

Dr. Luedeke, better known as Bart, served as Rider's fifth president from 1990 until his retirement in 2003. During his tenure, Rider saw the completion of several major facility projects, the dramatic expansion of its information technology infrastructure, the move to the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference, the establishment of a comprehensive advancement and marketing program, and the successful completion of its first-ever general capital campaign. Most importantly, Bart led both the successful merger with Westminster Choir College as well as Rider's achievement of university status in 1994, making Rider the first New Jersey institution to meet the state mandated guidelines.

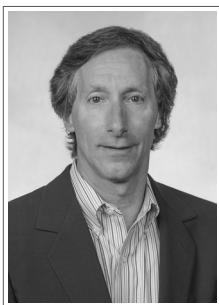
Rider's Student Center, fondly referred to as the BLC (The Bart Luedeke Center), was named in Bart's honor upon his retirement in recognition of his strong commitment to students and the true sense of community he fostered during his 32 years of service to the University.

Bart came to Rider in 1971 as the assistant to then President Frank N. Elliott. He served as Dean of the College of Continuing Studies, where he led a comprehensive redesign of the former Evening School and guided the creation of the Liberal Studies degree program. He also served as Associate Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs and Provost.

A strong advocate of the transformative power of higher education and athletics in the lives of students, Bart held leadership roles with several national organizations including the NCAA. He currently serves on several boards, among them the Charlotte W. Newcombe Foundation and Hanover College, his alma mater.

Bart earned a Ph.D. in Higher Education Administration from the University of Illinois, an M.Ed. in Counseling from Xavier University and a B.A. in Psychology from Hanover College.

2015 Distinguished Teaching Awards



DR. TAN MILLER

Associate Professor and Director

Global Supply Chain Management Program

Dr. Tan Miller joined Rider's faculty in September 2008 as a visiting professor. He was instrumental in developing Rider's global supply chain management program, which launched in September 2009 and is now ranked among the nation's top 25 programs by the global research firm, Gartner. Tan earned his master's and doctorate from the University of Pennsylvania and his MBA from the Wharton School. Before joining Rider, he worked in private industry for more than 20 years, including a role as regional director of distribution and head of U.S. consumer distribution at Johnson & Johnson, where he made time to volunteer on Rider's Science Advisory Board. Tan has influenced countless students to major in global supply chain management. In nominating him for the award, one student wrote, "Dr. Miller is one of the main reasons I chose Rider University. He is a great teacher and a superb advisor."



DR. NIKKI SHEPARDSON

Associate Professor, History Department

A member of Rider's faculty since 2000, Dr. Nikki Shepardson teaches early modern and modern European history. Students praise her passion for the subject and engaging teaching style. Nikki earned a doctorate in European history, as well as a master's in history, from Rutgers University. Her research concentrates on martyrs and martyrdom in sixteenth-century France as well as gender issues in the Renaissance and Reformation. Students, even non-history majors, line up to take multiple classes with Nikki. In nominating her, one student wrote, "Her passion for the material is contagious. Not being a history major myself, she makes her classes fun and exciting."

2015 Dominick A. Iorio Research Prize



DR. WENDY HEATH

Professor, Psychology Department

Dr. Wendy Heath has been a member of the Rider University faculty since 1993. She earned a master's and doctorate in experimental psychology from the University of Texas at Arlington. Over her career, Wendy's research has applied the tools of experimental psychology to examine how memory and judgment affect juror decision making. Her work, which has found an eager audience of legal scholars and psychologists, has led to a greater understanding of how jurors perceive defendant behavior — knowledge with important implications for justice in society. As a research scholar for the Innocence Project, a national nonprofit organization that works to exonerate the wrongfully convicted, Wendy has undertaken research that promises to dramatically impact public understanding of wrongful conviction. Through the example of her teaching and scholarship, Wendy serves as a model of excellence for the entire Rider community and beyond.

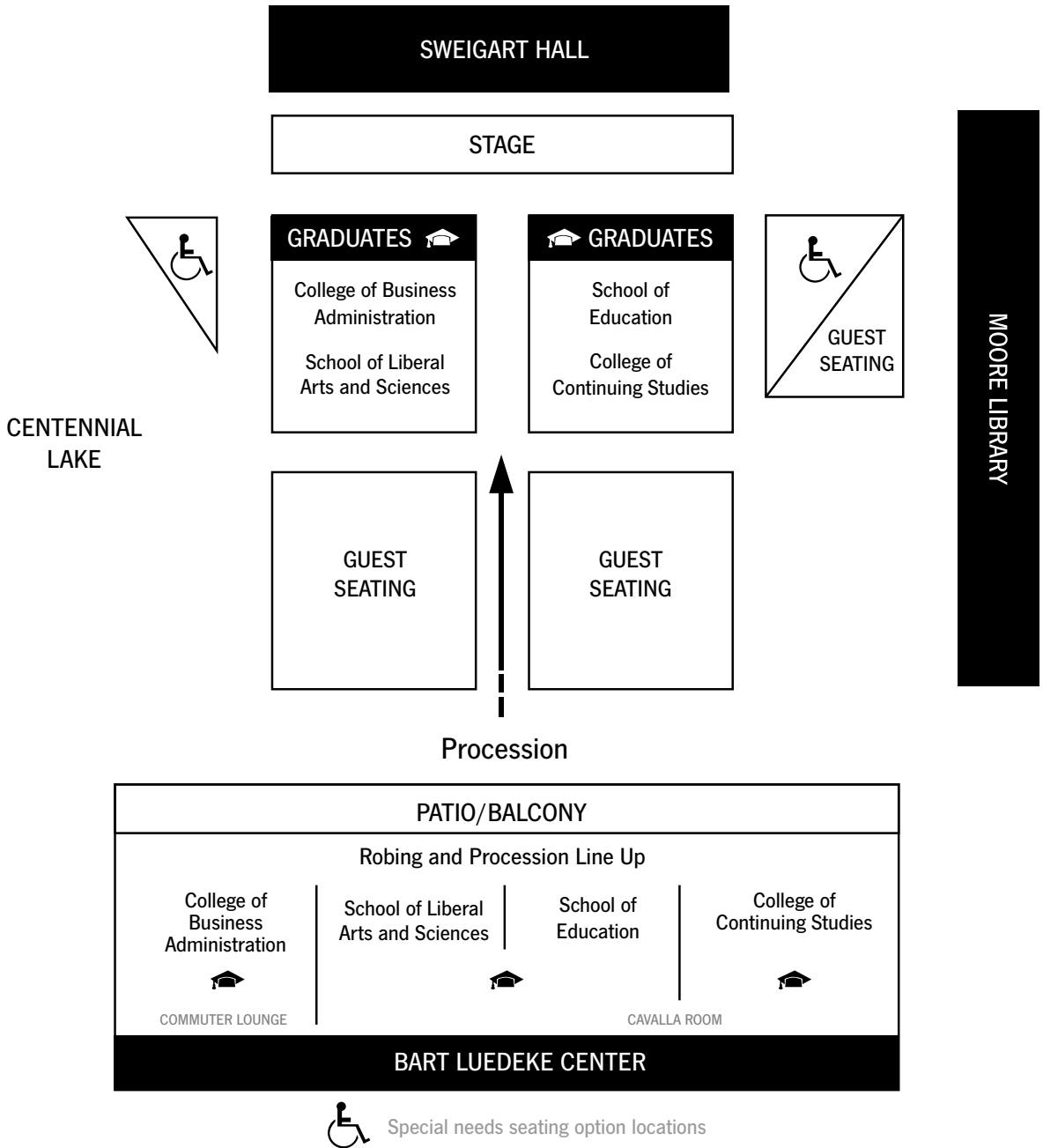
